This guidance is applicable to all those involved in student supervision at the school and outside of the school. The objective of the policy is to ensure that students are appropriately supervised during school activities and to consider supervision on arrival and departure from the school.

An Assistant Headteacher will be responsible for the implementation of this policy.

Students' arrival and departure

- Normal school hours are 08:45 – 15:30 for Secondary and 08:30 – 15:00 for Primary.
- Secondary students are not allowed on the college site until 07:45.
- Where students are on site outside of normal hours, at least two members of the staff will be present.
- There are a number of extra-curricular clubs that take place during the week which are always supervised.
- Members of the PE department will supervise students for home and away matches.
- A roll call is done for all students at the start of the morning and afternoon sessions. Registers are taken at the start of every lesson.
- Parents are responsible for notifying the school if their child is absent for any reason. The school will contact the parent if a child fails to arrive at school without an explanation.
- Year 12 and 13 students may leave the school site during the school day, but must sign out in the school office and then sign back in on their return.

Student Break Times

- Staff will supervise students during breaks and lunchtimes. A copy of the Primary and Secondary duty rotas can be seen on the following pages.
- At lunchtimes, students need to eat hot food in the Gym (under supervision), cold lunches can be eaten in the gym or in house rooms. Heads of House will be on duty in the house areas. During exam periods when the Gym is out of action, students can eat hot food in their house room.
- Students will be in designated areas on the playground, Sports Hall and Games Hall. Sports equipment will be provided for each year group, only foam footballs, foam rugby balls and low-pressure tennis balls will be allowed on the playgrounds.

Medical Support

- A qualified first aider is on duty in the school to administer first aid and deal with accidents and emergencies, including illness.
- A number of staff are trained first aiders and are available to give emergency first aid treatment.

Students will not have unsupervised access in designated areas which will include:

- gymnasium / climbing area.
- science laboratories and science technician areas.
- grounds, maintenance, catering and caretaking areas.

Designated areas will be kept securely locked when not in use.

Travelling to and from school

- Parents are responsible for ensuring that their children travel safely to and from school.
- Students are not supervised by a member of staff when travelling on school buses, but are expected to behave responsibly. Complaints of unsatisfactory behaviour will be investigated.
- 2 members of SMT will be on duty to supervise school bus departure.
